Sub: Issue of No Objection Certificate Jasmine Education & Charitable Trust, Bidar for establishment of Jasmine B.Ed. College, Bidar for the academic year 2007-2008.

PREAMBLE:

1) The State Government has lifted the ban on issue of *No Objection Certificates* for establishment of B.Ed/B.P.Ed colleges in all mediums of instruction from the academic year 2003-2004 in G.O dated: 29-04-2003. The State Government has decided to issue NOC's for establishment of New B.Ed & B.P.Ed Colleges during the academic year 2007-08. As a sequel to this, the Universities were directed to advertise calling for applications for establishment of B.Ed/B.P.Ed colleges for the academic year 2007-2008 and to submit them to Government after complying with the procedure stipulated in Section 59 of the KSU Act, 2000, to enable it to consider for grant of NOCs under regulations 5 (e) of the NCTE Regulations 1995.

2) The **Gulbarga University, Gulbarga** had called for applications to start B.Ed/B.P.Ed Colleges. The **Gulbarga University, Gulbarga** after processing the application Under Section 59 of the KSU Act, 2000 has submitted the application to the Government along with necessary documents with a recommendation to grant NOC to **Jasmine Education & Charitable Trust, Bidar for establishment of Jasmine B.Ed. College, Bilal Colony, Bidar** for the academic year 2007-08. The proposal has been examined and hence this order.

3) Government of Karnataka is pleased to grant *No-Objection Certificate* to **Jasmine Education & Charitable Trust, Bidar** for establishment of **Jasmine B.Ed. College, Bilal Colony, Bidar** for offering **B.Ed** course with an intake of **100 (One hundred)** subject to fulfilling the conditions of LIC from the academic year **2007-2008** under Regulation 5(e) of the NCTE Regulations 1995, subject to the following conditions:-



- (1) No grant-in-aid shall be sought from Government for running the proposed college; it shall be subject to permanently unaided policy of the State Government. The institution shall given an undertaking to Government to this effect at the time of sanctioning affiliation based on the recognition to be granted by the NCTE-SRC.
- (2) The institution shall provide adequate infrastructure, staff etc., as per the norms and standards, prescribed by the National Council for Teachers Education and also the affiliating University;
- (1) The institution shall abide by the orders/rules of the State Government and the statutes and regulations of the affiliating University issued from time to time with regard to admission policy and recruitment of staff to the institution etc;
- (2) The institution shall collect 'Tuition fee' and 'Other fees' as prescribed by the State Government from time to time. The amount collected shall be utilized by the institution in accordance with rules;
- (3) The management should start the institution only after obtaining recognition from the National Council for Teacher Education under Section 14 of the NCTE Act, 1993.
